## Statement Regarding Al-Aqsa Mosque/Al-Haram Al-Sharif

July 27, 2023

We, the Patriarchs and Heads of Churches in Jerusalem, gather in spirit with heavy hearts and profound concern to address the lamentable events that have unfolded upon the grounds of the Al-Aqsa Mosque/Al-Haram Al-Sharif on this solemn day, the twenty-seventh of July. We bear witness to the intrusion by Israeli radicals, a grievous violation that strikes at the very core of the sanctity of Jerusalem, the City of Peace.

As spiritual shepherds in this venerable land, we are bound by duty to uphold the sanctity of all holy sites. Amongst them, Al-Aqsa Mosque/Al-Haram Al-Sharif, entrusted to the exclusive right of our Muslim brethren, and held under the reverent custodianship of the Hashemites, in harmony with the rest of the Christian and Muslim holy sites.

With profound dismay, we witness the erosion of safety for Muslim worshipers and the affront to the dignity of the Palestinian people, whose freedom to worship is being unjustly constrained.
